She is founding editor of The American Council on Immersion Education (ACIE) Newsletter, now in its 13th year of publication, and has worked with over 50 immersion programs across the U.S. and abroad. Dr. Fortune is regularly invited as a lecturer in immersion education. Her current work focuses on struggling immersion learners, K-8 oral proficiency development, and language and literacy development in early total Chinese immersion programs.
